- 6. School Wide Grading Policy
 - -2023-2024 Jacobson ES Grading Reform guidelines (aligned with CCSD's guidelines)
 - -Late work: Marked with a L initially if not submitted by deadline entered as an M for 50%. Monthly progress reports will be sent home with missing assignments, all missing work due 10 days prior to the end of the semester.
 - -Reassessment policy: Students earning a D, F or N on a summative assessment can request in writing to retake a test up to 2 times. Students who scored a A, B or C on a summative assessment can be reassessed 1 time per writing in request by student or parent, only those questions missed will be reassessed, summative assessments due 10 days before the end of the semester, reassessment guidelines as determined by IEP/504 accommodations will supercede District and School-side policies.
 - -Gradebook Category weighting: 20% formative, 80% summative
 - -Grading: We will follow CCSD Grading Reform Guidelines, all grades will be in Infinite campus, progress reports will be sent home monthly, unsatisfactory notices will be sent home twice a year
 - -Homework: Homework may be given but will not be graded.
 - -Parent Communication: Administration will have parent meetings to disperse school-wide information, all teachers will hold a Meet and Greet before school starts, classroom teachers will create welcome letters, parent communication through class dojo, & teachers will set up school voicemails.
 - -Behavior Management: School wide Jacobson Expectations serve as our code of conduct. Minor behavior infractions handled within the classroom.

Major behavior infractions will be referred to administration through a referral on Infinite Campus.
